Role Purpose: The main purpose of this volunteer role is to support to the Dedicated Neighbourhood Teams.

Some of the tasks we would like your help with:

- Attending/arranging meetings/visits and providing support at arranged meetings/visits
- Involvement in crime prevention initiatives, including identifying areas requiring intervention, conducting home security visits, distributing leaflets, etc.
- Working with partners to solve locally identified problems
- Conducting telephone call backs on behalf of local officers
- Arranging/attending community based events
- Administrative support
- Involvement in other locally based operations

What skills you need:

- Good communication skills
- Ability to work as part of a team
- Good organisational skills
- To enjoy talking to people

What training and support you will receive:

You will take part in an induction to help you understand your role and how the force works, along with training on how to use specialist databases and IT systems.

We have Lead Volunteers on each of our 8 neighbourhood Policing Areas (NPA's). Part of their role is to support volunteers, so they will be able to assist you with any problems or questions you may have throughout your time as a Police Support Volunteer with Leicestershire Police.
