Activities / Tasks	<ul> <li>Working closely with the Fraud Assess and Protect Officer within the Economic Crime Unit to deliver Fraud Protect initiatives and events.</li> <li>To provide support and co-ordination in relation to identifying vulnerability and themes amongst Fraud victims.</li> <li>Delivery of Protect advice and support.</li> <li>Working collaboratively with police officers and staff to support projects and local initiatives</li> <li>Using IT applications such as Microsoft Excel and Microsoft Word to write letters, emails and compile reports.</li> <li>Working within a confidential and sensitive environment</li> </ul>
