What does this activity involve?

•Engaging with the community to deliver crime prevention advice both on the street and at local events.

Conducting surveys with members of the public to enhance public safety
Preparing for crime prevention initiatives, collating information and materials.
Working collaboratively with police officers and staff to support local priorities
Using IT applications such as Microsoft Excel and Microsoft Word to write letters, leaflets and reports.

Skills required:

Written communication along with speaking to people face to face and on the telephone in a professional and confident manner is required. You should have basic IT skills, but will receive training on any systems required. Full, clean driving licence is essential for this role.

Note: Crime prevention training will be provided as part of this role.
